



General Information and Instructions

Morning Garden Parent-Child classes are for children ages 2 to 4 years (at time of enrollment), with a parent, guardian, or other caregiver. Morning Garden classes are offered once a week on *Tuesday* or *Wednesday* mornings from 8:30 am - 12 pm. Tuition includes healthy snacks and materials. Class size is limited to 9 children. Infants and toddlers (18-24 months) may come with siblings, but please indicate this on the application form. There is a \$40.00 tuition fee per sibling.

Morning Garden Weekly Structure

Morning Garden offers parents and children an introductory experience with Waldorf education by offering a soft, gentle space with play areas, all natural toys and a warm, friendly atmosphere for parents to share ideas, stories and friendship. With rhythm and consistency, the class teacher guides children and parents through the morning's activities which include outdoor play, circle time with songs and rhymes, creative play, snack and story time. Meaningful work and activity are offered to parents and children as a way of nurturing the child's imitative skills.

You will be invoiced. Payments received on or before the discounted tuition due dates reflect a \$25 discount. The Annual Session rate requires that \$305 be paid in full by August 11 and that the remainder be paid in full by November 9. Payments received after the class start date will be assessed a late fee of \$25.

A \$75 deposit is required at the time of application. The deposit may be rolled over to secure a spot in a subsequent session or refunded at the end of the session. The deposit will be forfeited if the family withdraws 4 weeks or less before the beginning of a session.
