



Dear Parents:

We are applying for funds to purchase materials for our students. Pennsylvania State Law authorizes the loan of textbooks by the Secretary of Education for Public Schools (Act 195) as well as the loan of instructional materials (Act 90). Although the term “Loan” is used, what actually happens is that Pennsylvania gives non-public schools an amount to spend based on each school’s enrollment. There are specific limitations as to what may be purchased with the money.

To participate in these programs, the statutes required that the parent(s) of each child attending our school individually request a loan of textbooks and instructional materials. Below is the individual request form. Please sign the form, date it, and return it to the school. We are required to keep these forms on file.
